- Work Experience
- Major Extracurricular Activities – how activities contributed to personal growth, offices held, and/or honor/awards received
- Community Activities – number of years of participation, offices held, and/or honor/awards received
- Activities (hobbies, responsibilities, self-directed studies) – how contributed to personal growth
- Crime Convictions – Statement as to why these convictions will not affect entrance into secondary education
- List of other scholarship awarded not affiliated with the Decatur County Community Scholarship Foundation
- Statement of intended use of scholarship dollars; should also include brief summary of personal goals and future plans
- PSAT AND SAT scores
- Official Transcripts from Guidance Counselor or Bursar's Office – should include GPA, Class Rank, and Type of Diploma
- FASFA credit number
